




WHY NIZHNY NOVGOROD?

Today's technologies require workers to have a high level of knowledge and skills. The market requires highly-educated workers for all industries and jobs.

Nizhny Novgorod Region is host to:

- **56** private and public institutions of higher education
- > 106 organizations active in education and academia

In addition, Nizhny Novgorod has positive experience of training local workers specifically to meet the requirements of investment projects. The Corporate University and Learning Centre of one of the largest car manufacturers in Russia, GAZ Group,

trains the staff needed by investment projects. For example, employees are currently being trained for a joint project involving GAZ Group and Volkswagen Group RUS.
